Audiovisual Materials

CDs, cassette tapes, DVDs and VHS video tapes are available for loan from Ota City libraries. Visual materials must be returned to the same library from which they were borrowed.

Reservation and Request Services

If desired books are out on loan, an arrangement can be made at the desk to notify you upon its return. Availability of items can be checked and items can be reserved through the Internet service (see below).

The library can also help with the borrowing of materials not available in Ota City libraries, through the use of the Tokyo Metropolitan inter-library loan program. A/V materials cannot be requested.

Internet Search and Reservation Services

The online service can also be used to check the availability of items and status of materials you have reserved or have checked out. (To use the online service, you must register and acquire a password beforehand).


Children's Room




Library Card Registration and Borrowing Library Materials


When registering for a library card, a document proving place of residence must be shown. For children under the age of 15, a signature from a guardian is required.


